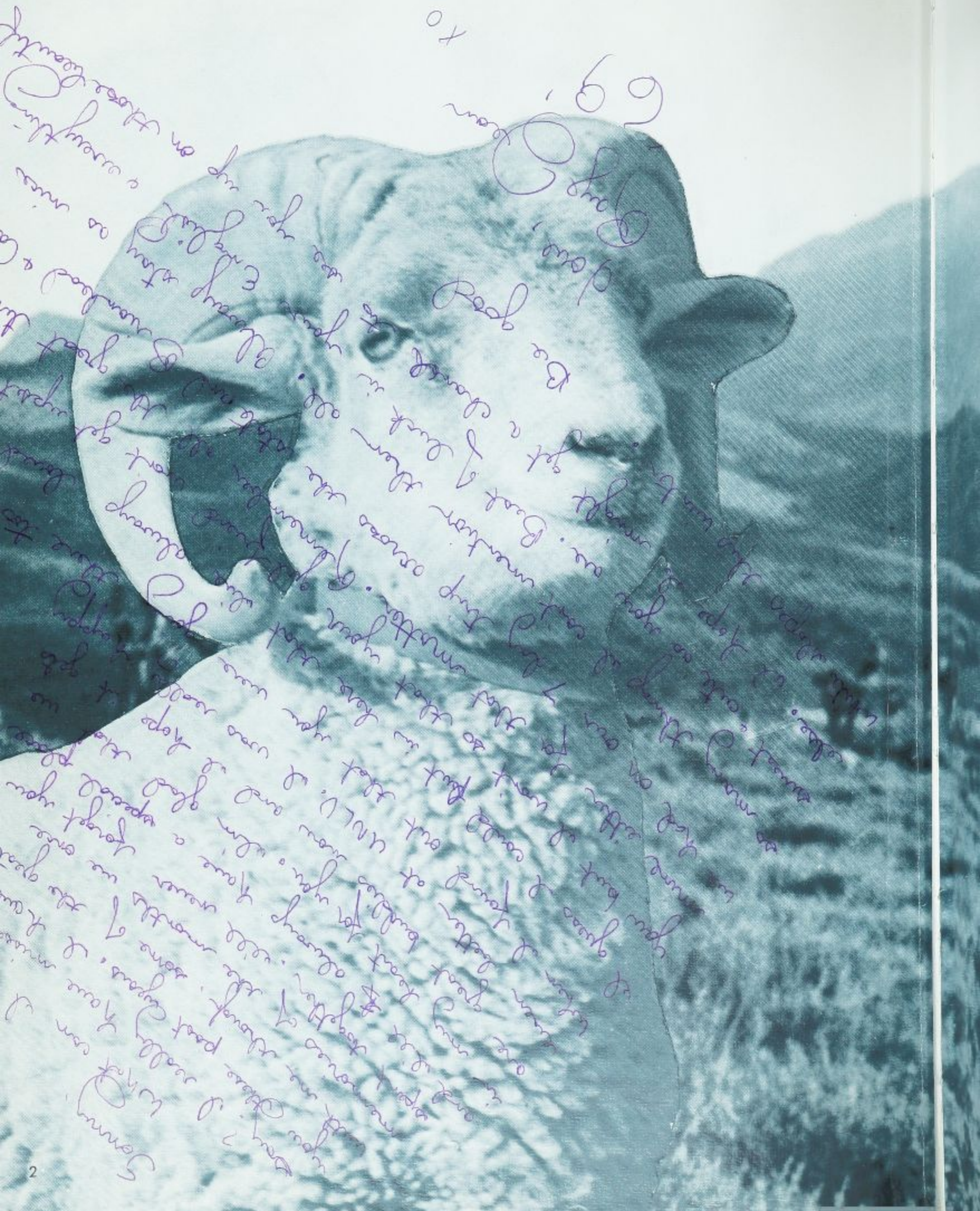

FOREWORD

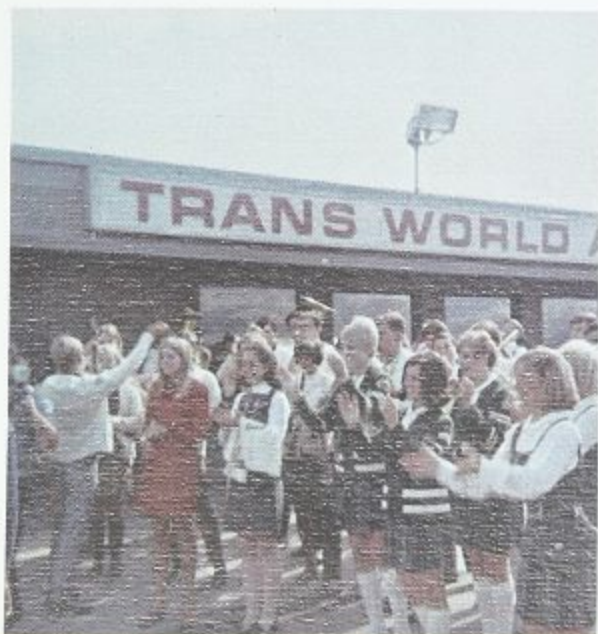
As the sands of the desert shift and change with the passage of years, so the Sands of Time manipulate, move, and mold our lives at school.

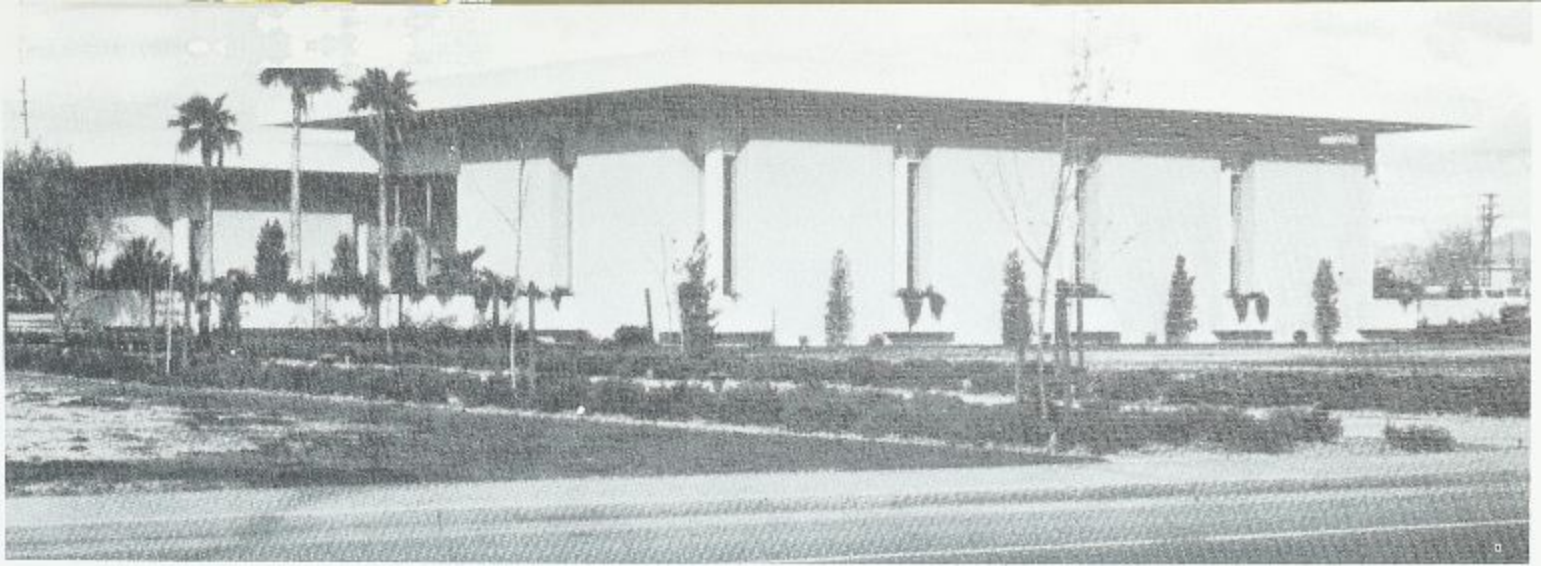


Many years of effort culminated in the completion, late in 1966, of the new North Las Vegas City Hall, constructed on twenty-one acres of land in the heart of the city on Civic Center Drive north of Lake Mead Boulevard. The City Hall, costing over one million dollars, is designed to blend with the mountainous Nevada terrain and incorporates acres of beautiful trees and landscaping which accent the formal lines of the edifice itself. Subdued light filters through the thousands of square feet of tinted glass and gives a feeling of coolness, while the warmth of the walnut paneling and luster of over 3,000 square feet of marble paneling, in the entry and hallways, highlight the beauty of the structure. The structure is designed to be expanded as North Las Vegas, the second largest city in area, and third largest in population in Nevada continues to grow.



The Police and Fire Departments and the City Jail are located at Bruce Street and Lake Mead Boulevard. There are presently 35 firemen employed at the Fire Department and 2 engines, 1 rescue vehicle, and 2 tankers constitute the special equipment. Our Police Force has 53 regular officers, 18 volunteers, 6 crossing guards with six patrol cars, six motorcycles, and six unmarked cars.

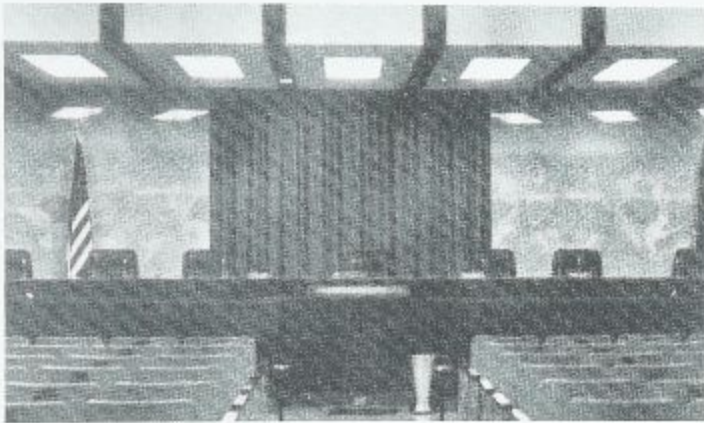




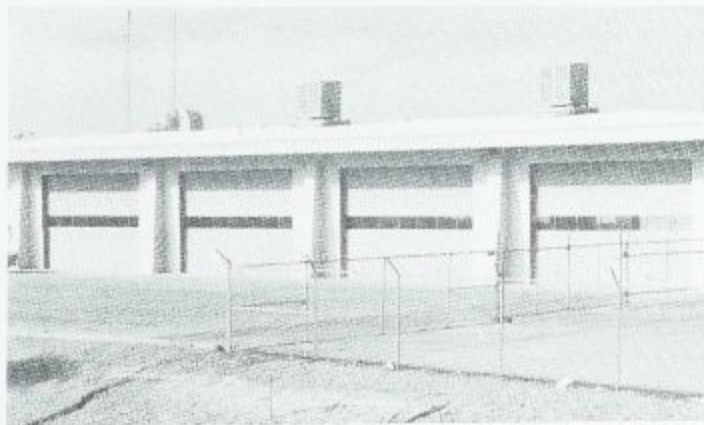
PUBLIC FACILITIES

The library, joined by a tree-lined walk to the City Hall, has a capacity of 30,300 volumes. Twenty thousand volumes are now in circulation or reposing on the book stacks which total one-half mile of shelv-

ing. The 32,000 square feet of glass provides shaded light complementing the fluorescent lighting. Landscaped inside and out, the Library has an openness that belies the desert extremes of temperature.



The Council Chambers, paneled in matched walnut, has 198 theater seats for the public. Behind the Council table, also in matched walnut, and flanked by marble panels, a curtain conceals a projector screen and map boards. Individual microphones for the Council and public provide adequate sound capabilities. Public hearings can now be held comfortably without unnecessary crowding.



The Public Works Yard which houses the Street and Utility Departments and City Garage is located on the north side of Brooks Street just east of North Commerce and is one of the finest facilities of its kind in the area, with several modern innovations such as a custom designed grease pit and heavy equipment hoist.

The new Morris R. Weir Fire Station augments our fire system by supplying fire services to the northern portion of the urbanized area of the city.



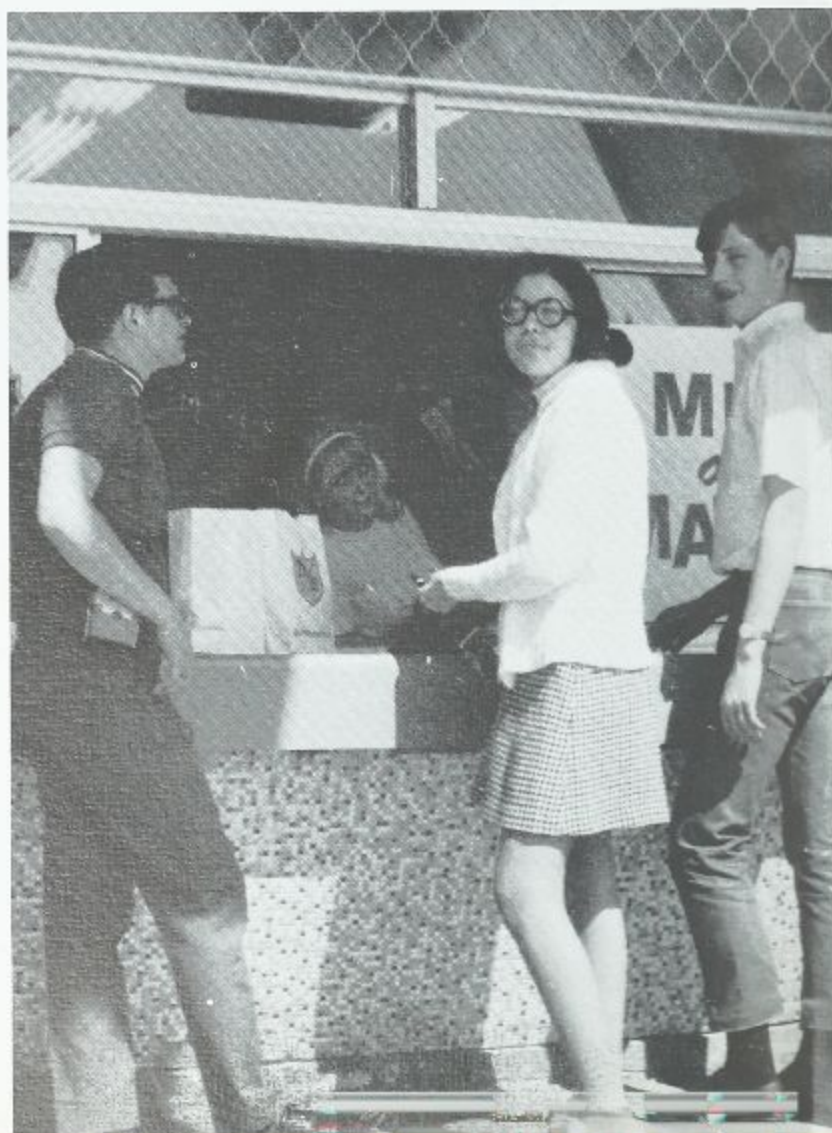
